Spiderveins

Spiderveins, or *Telangiectasia*, are dilated capillaries. These small blood vessels can be seen under the skin as a spidery or branching network or as single fine lines, usually appearing red, purple, or blue. They can be cleared up by Sclerotherapy injection.

Varicose Veins

Varicose veins are enlarged blood vessels that protrude above the surface of the skin, typically found in the backs of calves or inside of the legs.

They occur when weakness in the valves allows blood to pool and collect, enlarging the veins, a condition known as Venous Insufficiency Syndrome, or reversed blood flow in the veins. Causes include increased pressure such as from prolonged standing, inherited genetic weakness, hormonal variation, and pregnancy.

Symptoms may involve burning, swelling, cramping, throbbing, and leg fatigue. Often there are no painful symptoms, but patients will choose to have their veins treated for cosmetic appeal.

Injection Procedure

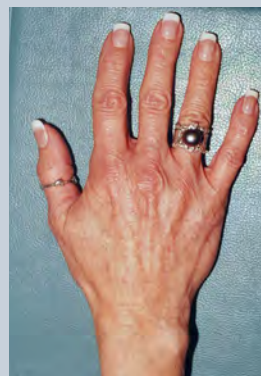
At Schick Vein Care, we inject the unwanted veins directly with a sclerosing solution, using extremely small needles. This medication irritates the lining of the vein walls, causing them to close together. As they heal, they form scar tissue which is reabsorbed by the body, and the veins begin to fade or disappear. The circulatory system continues to transport blood towards the heart through deeper, underlying veins.

Most patients find that these injections are not very painful; they feel like a series of pin pricks. After treatment, daily activity can resume right away.

Sclerotherapy is a gradual process, since the problem veins will need to be injected more than once. Vein Treatment consists of several separate treatment sessions (most patients average two to three), scheduled a couple of weeks apart.
